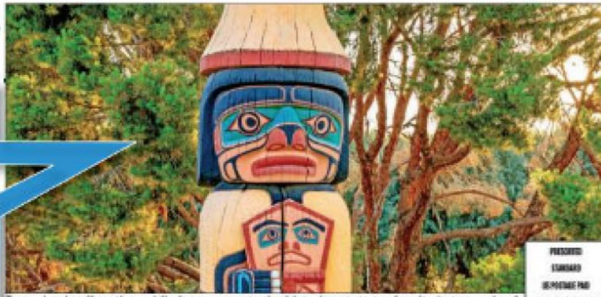

Desert Jet Center Opens

Desert Jet Center in Thermal, CA, opened its full-service 32,500 square foot facility with Jared Fox, Chief Executive Officer just in time for 2020 travelers. Whether you are contemplating a flight to Las Vegas or Chicago, here's the ideal almost too good to be true alternative to a regular airline ticket,

convoluted airline points, and the nightmare of long lines that have made the TSA and aviation exercise in patience.

The Jet Center is on alert to make your flight a pleasure. TSA trauma aside, this is the Coachella Valley's first and only fixed-base operator (FBO). Making this even more impressive is this their 22,500 sq. ft hangar having the

convenience and comfort of a terminal serving the needs of business aviation with ground services that include repair, on-site maintenance supported by a staff of factory-trained certified professionals was a top priority.

seating seven passengers to the Bombardier Challenger 300 seating ten passengers capable of flying coast to coast have proven to be time-saving and cost-effective. Desert Jet is the Coachella Valley's first and only true full-service fixed-base operator (FBO) offering "everything that an aircraft or operator could ever need from ground handling, ramp parking and maintenance assistance to acquisitions, sales and aircraft management.

Jared Fox, Chief Executive Officer, said: "whether you want to travel on a charter flight, increase the value, efficiency and safety of the operation of your own aircraft

or land in the Coachella Valley from another destination, Desert Jet meets your needs in a personalized, anticipatory fashion."

Taking that to the next level for pet owners, Chris Little Direction of Marketing said that pets are welcome aboard Desert Jet as they can travel in the cabin of the aircraft on their owner's lap or the seats next to them. On Desert Jet we treat pets just like family members".

She added, "pets are welcome in all Desert Jet planes and FBO facilities." Desert Jet continues to support local charities as well, in the past, raising an average of \$50,000 annually for organization such as St. Jude's

Children's Hospital, Angel Flight West, and sponsoring

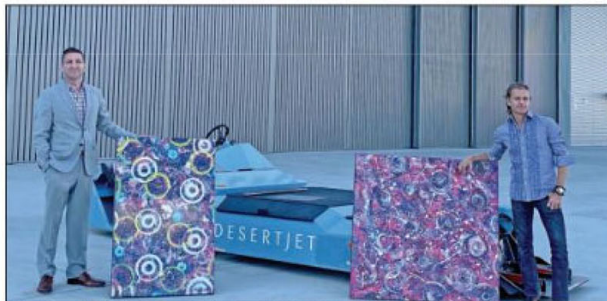
various community events from the American Heart
